## Class Schedule for January & February 2012

### Individual Knitting or Crochet Lessons

Having difficulty with a project? We can help you! Want to learn a new technique or skill? We can teach you! Pick your project, pick your time and we will hold an individual knitting or crochet lesson for you. If you are going to be in the area for a few days, this class will work for you. We also can guide you with a project that you can easily complete after your lesson.

Cost: \$20 for the first hour, \$5 for each additional hour. 10% class discount on yarn.

### New Session of Knitting 101

Mondays 6:00 pm - 7:30 pm with Nancy; Thursdays 1:30 pm - 3:00 pm with Sue, from January 2 to February 23

Learn how to hold and use knitting needles, to cast-on, knit, purl and bind-off. Find out about tension and how to knit a gauge swatch. Make either a Garter Stitch (knit, knit, knit) or Ribbed (knit, purl) Scarf.

Cost: \$50 – Attend 1, 2, 3 or all 17 classes. Class is informal and designed to meet your individual needs. You can progress at your own rate. 10% class discount on yarn, needles and notions needed for the class (purchased during first class).

### New Session of Knitting 102 – Advanced Beginners

Mondays 6:00pm - 7:30 pm with Nancy; Thursdays 2 pm - 3:30 pm with Sue, from January 2 to February 23

Now that you know how to cast-on, knit, purl and bind-off, it's time to tackle a harder project. Consider things like a felted bag, hat, mittens or basket weave and seed stitch scarves. Learn to increase and decrease and to knit in the round. You will learn a new knitting skill every week.

Cost: \$50 – Attend 1, 2, 3 or all 17 classes. Class is informal and designed to meet your individual needs. You can progress at your own rate. 10% class discount on yarn, needles and notions needed for the class (purchased during first class).

### 101 & 102 Crochet Class – 3 Classes Instructor: Amy

Sundays, January 8 & 29, February 19, 1:00 pm – 2:30 pm

The class is designed for all levels. We can teach the novice basic stitches, help the crocheter continue on through a project or assist the knitter with finishing edges. Amy will review basic crochet stitches - slip stitch, single crochet, half-double crochet, double crochet and treble crochet stitches and buttonholes. Learn the crochet, crab, picots, shell, triangle, double chain and puff edge. Edge finishing will include how to pick-up and crochet the traditional stitches.

Cost \$40 – 3 classes. Stop in to make a special request and we will teach it. 10% class discount on yarn.

### Leah Pullover – 3 Classes Instructor: Amy

Tuesdays, January 10, February 7 & March 6, 10:00 am – Noon

Winter is here and it is the perfect time to try something new and crochet a sweater for your toddler. We have selected the Leah pullover from the book Baby Blueprint Crochet. It is adorned with 3 accent buttons to make it even more adorable. The sweater is constructed from the top down which is a twist on the way sweaters are usually created. During this class you'll be building your skills while working a two row repeat for the Bonny Stitch pattern. You will become familiar with stitch diagrams & symbols, blocking and adding buttons & snaps to a sweater. Please select a DK weight yarn and make a gauge swatch using a hook size needed to obtain gauge.

Cost \$50– Stop in before class begins and we'll help you pick out a wonderful color. 10% class discount on yarn.

**Thrummed Mittens – 2 Classes** Instructor: Kristie  
Sunday, January 8 & February 12, 1:30 pm – 3:30 pm

Thrummed mittens have been around for a couple hundred years in Newfoundland and Labrador. The term thrum refers to yarn waste from weaving looms. In mittens, a thrum is a little wisp of unspun fleece or roving that is knit into the inside of your mittens, making them soft, fuzzy and freakishly warm.

Cost \$40 - 2 classes. The class will include the pattern and 10% class discount on yarn and roving.

**Beginning Sock – 3 Classes** Instructor: Sue  
Thursdays, January 12 & February 9, 3 pm – 5 pm

Using a basic sock pattern, you will learn to make socks on double-pointed needles. The first session will teach you to cast on, join in the round and knit the cuff and leg. The second session will teach you to divide and turn the heel and shape the gusset. The third session will teach you the completion of the foot and toe. For the more advanced knitters you can pick out a more challenging pattern to work on in class.

Cost \$45 - 3 classes. We will have a wide range of sock yarn including Dream in Color Smooshy, Schaefer Nicole, Madelinetosh Tosh Sock, Misti Alpaca, Jitterbug, Fleece Artist BFL Sock, Malabrigo yarns from which to pick. . Stop in before the first class and Sue will help you pick your yarn. 10% class discount on yarn.

**Beaded Cuff, Butin Collar & Rippled – 1 Class** Instructor: Amy  
Saturday, February 4, 10:00 am – 1 pm

*Beaded Cuffs, Butin Collar and Rippled* by Laura Nelkin will be offered in one class. Pick your kit and we will walk you through the pattern. This is a fun way to learn to knit with beads.

\$30.00 – 1 class. Come by to pick out your kits. You will receive a 10% class discount on kits and patterns.

**Pattern & Yarn Interpretation – 1 Class** Instructor: Nancy  
Saturday, February 18, 10 am – 3 pm

We will supply you with a pattern that we will interpret in class, explaining the details so you will have a full understanding of the project. Then we will have you pick out the yarn for the project and explain label details and what they mean.

Cost \$40 - 2 classes. The class will include sample pattern, 10% class discount on yarn & pattern you purchase during class.
