Summer 2010 Class Schedule

New session of Knitting 101

Mondays 5 - 6:30 and Thursdays 2 – 3:30, starting July 1 to August 30 (no class July 5)

Learn how to hold and use knitting needles, to cast-on, knit, purl and bind-off. Find out about tension and how to knit to gauge. Make either Garter Stitch (knit, knit, knit) or Ribbed (knit, purl) Scarf.

Cost: \$45 – Attend 1, 2, 3 or all 17 classes. Class is informal and designed to meet your individual needs. You can progress at your own rate. 10% class discount on yarn, needles and notions needed for the class (purchased during first class).

New session of Knitting 102 – Advanced Beginners

Mondays 5 - 6:30 and Thursdays 2 – 3:30, starting July 1 to August 30 (no class July 5)

Now that you know how to cast-on, knit, purl and bind-off, it's time to tackle a harder project – consider things like a felted bag, hat, mittens, or basketweave and seed stitch scarves. Learn to increase and decrease; and to knit in the round. You will learn a new knitting skill every week.

Cost: \$45 – Attend 1, 2, 3 or all 17 classes. Class is informal and designed to meet your individual needs. You can progress at your own rate. 10% class discount on yarn, needles and notions needed for the class (purchased during first class).

Socks Workshop – 4 Classes

Fridays 5 – 6:30, July 2 to July 23

Sue will be introducing you to the Houdini Socks. Houdini socks begin with a sock footprint – toe up design, foot-shaped tube closed on both ends – with no apparent way in, and no leg. You can also use your class time to learn the four basics needed for knitting socks – 1. Casting on and getting started, 2. Turning the heel, 3. Picking up the gusset and knitting the foot, 4. Toe decreases and the Kitchener Stitch. OR bring the socks on which you're already working; and we'll help with any questions.

Cost \$45 - 4 classes. We will have a nice variety of Dream in Color, Schaefer Lola or Anne, Madelinetosh Tosh Sock, Lorna's Laces Shephard Sock, and Koigu Premium Merino. Come early to the first class to pick your yarn. 10% class discount on yarn, pattern, needles and notions needed for class.

Felted Tote Bag

Thursdays 5 - 6:30, August 5 to 26

What knitter can't use another tote bag for all those works in progress? Knit a TALL TOTE for big projects or a SMALL TOTE for small projects. Either tote can become a purse with the addition of a button flap.

Cost \$25 – Stop in before class begins and we'll help you pick out a nice color combination. 10% class discount on yarn, needles and notions needed for class.

Lace Scarf

Fridays 5 – 6:30, August 6 to 27

Lace knitting incorporates many stitches & techniques that will give you an open weave which will create a beautiful drape. You will be able to choose one of these patterns for the class; Halcyon, Branching Out or Falling Water.

Cost \$25 – Stop in before class begins and we'll help you pick out your pattern, the right yarn and needles. 10% class discount on yarn, needles and notions needed for class. Pattern included; used with permission.

Undulating Waves Scarf (Also the July Cotton Club project)

Wednesdays 6 – 7:30, August 4 & 18

Christy has enjoyed prepping for this class. This pattern is fun & easy once you get into the groove of the repeat, stringing beads with yarn over. She has completed a sample for you to see and hold.

Cost \$25 – Stop in before class begins and we'll help you pick out your pattern, the right yarn and needles. 10% class discount on yarn, needles and notions needed for class. Pattern included; used with permission.

Kids Knit Workshop

Tuesdays & Wednesdays 10:30-11:30, or by appointment.
