Knitting 101 - Beginners

Mondays 5 - 6:30 pm and Thursdays 10:30 am - noon, March 1 – April 29

Learn how to hold and use knitting needles, to cast-on, knit, purl and bind-off. Find out about tension and how to knit to gauge. Project will be your choice of either Garter Stitch (knit, knit, knit) or Ribbed (knit, purl) Scarf.

Cost: \$45 – Attend 1, 2, 3 or all 18 classes. Class is informal and designed to meet your individual needs. You can progress at your own rate. 10% class discount on yarn, needles and notions needed for the class, purchased during first class.

Knitting 102 – Advanced Beginners

Mondays 5 - 6:30 pm and Thursdays 10:30 am - noon, March 1 – April 29

Now t

hat you know how to cast-on, knit, purl and bind-off, it's time to tackle a harder project – consider things like a simple felted bag, a Lizard Ridge Afghan, or basketweave and seed stitch scarves. Learn to increase and decrease; and to knit in the round.

Cost: \$45 – Attend 1, 2, 3 or all 18 classes. Class is informal and designed to meet your individual needs. You can progress at your own rate. 10% class discount on yarn, needles and notions needed for the class, purchased during first class.

Finishing School – 4 Classes

Thursdays 4:30 – 6 pm, March 25 & April 15; and Saturdays 1:30 – 3 pm, April 10 and 24

Offered by popular demand by many of our regular customers. Bring in your works in progress; and we'll tackle some of the toughest parts of knitting objects – blocking, seaming, and edging. Learn seam stitches including Kitchener, 3-needle bind-off, and mattress stitch. Edge finishing will include how to pick-up and knit smooth bands and collars as well as traditional crochet stitches. We can also explore various decorative cast-on edge treatments and “finishing touches” including I-cord, fringe, and pom poms. This is your class – make it what you want.

Cost \$40 - for all four classes; or come to any one (or more) class for just \$15/class

Socks Workshop – 4 Classes

Fridays (you asked for this date/time!) 4:30 – 6 pm, March 5 & 19, April 9 & 23

We will cover the four basics needed for knitting socks – 1. Casting on and getting started, 2. Turning the heel, 3. Picking up the gusset and knitting the foot, 4. Toe decreases and the Kitchener Stitch - OR - bring the socks on which you're working. We'll help with any questions or problems.

Cost \$45 - 4 classes. We will have a nice variety of Dream in Color Classy or Schaefer Lola. Come early to first class to pick your yarn. 10% class discount on yarn, pattern, needles and notions needed for class.

Syncopation Bag

Sunday 3 - 4:30 pm, April 11

This graceful bag is achieved by clever placement of mitered squares and rectangles. It's pure fun to knit. It's the perfect bag to show off striated yarns or those with long color repeats.

Cost \$20 – Stop in before class begins and we'll help you pick out a nice color combination. 10% class discount on yarn, pattern, needles and notions needed for class.

Mobius Cowl – the April Scarf Club project (you don't need to be in club to make this scarf)

Tuesday 6 - 7:30 pm, April 6

Mobius knitting is a fun and easy technique to learn (it's got to be fun – anytime you twist your stitches on purpose); and the finished object has a beautiful drape (because you twisted your stitches). In just this one class you'll be on your way to knitting a beautiful and interesting cowl-style scarf.

Cost \$20 – Stop in before class begins and we'll help you pick out the right yarn and needles. 10% class discount on yarn, needles and notions needed for class. Pattern included; used with permission.

Versatile Triangle Scarf – the May Scarf Club project

(you don't need to be in club to make this scarf)

Tuesday 6 - 7:30 pm, April 27

This classic pattern has a ton of variations. We'll help you decide which one is right for you; and get you going in the right direction with the edge design and increases. Pairing the right yarn and needles is essential in this project; and we'll help you with that, too.

Turn a Square Hat – 2 Classes

Tuesdays 3 - 4:30 pm, March 30 and April 6

This hat pattern, by Jared Flood of Brooklyn Tweed fame, has become one of the most knitted hat patterns in history. It's loved by men, women, boys and girls, whether skiing, grocery shopping, snowboarding, taking a walk, hiking, running errands....I could go on but you get the point. You'll learn how to hold and use circular and double point needles, basic stripping techniques and raised ribbing.

Cost \$30 – Stop in before class begins and we'll help you pick out your yarn. 10% class discount on yarn, needles and notions needed for class. Pattern included; used with permission.

Knitting for Kids

Saturdays 10:30 am - noon, or any other day/time – just call the shop to schedule.

This class offers a simple project that will teach the basics – casting on, the knit and purl stitch, and binding off. We'll also talk about yarns, needles and very basic troubleshooting.
